Now this deed witnesses

That in consideration of Icopal guaranteeing the Contractor's workmanship in respect of work carried out under the Icopal Guarantee Scheme the Contractor **undertakes** to indemnify Icopal against all claims, demands, proceedings, damages, costs and expenses sustained incurred or payable by Icopal to any third party (its successors and assigns) to whom Icopal has guaranteed the Contractor's workmanship insofar as and to the extent that the same has arisen under the Icopal Guarantee Scheme as a result of any act, neglect or default of the Contractor, its servants or agents.

The Contractor further undertakes to arrange insurance to cover for:

- a.) Employers liability for a minimum of ten million pounds,
- b.) Third party liabilities, including all servants, contractors and agents involved with an Icopal roof project for a minimum cover of two million pounds

and

c.) Contract works for the value of the completed works. A certificate of insurance must be supplied to Icopal on an annual basis.

All claims will be subject to independent arbitration.
